

## Are Work Pass holders allowed to drive on public roads for work?

Work Pass holders are allowed to drive on Singapore roads for work in the following conditions:

<b><i>Type of Passholders</i></b>	<b><i>All conditions must be met:</i></b>
<b>Work Permit (WP) holders in Sectors:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Construction</b></li><li>• <b>Marine shipyard</b></li><li>• <b>Process</b></li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Must hold valid driving licence recognised by the Traffic Police.</li><li>• Must hold driving-related occupations such as “Lorry/Truck Driver”, “Driver” or “Worker-cum-Driver”.</li></ul>
<b>WP holders in Manufacturing sector</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Must hold valid driving licence recognised by the Traffic Police.</li><li>• Must be required in their course of work.</li><li>• Must be in accordance with their occupation stated on their Work Permit.</li></ul>
<b>WP holders in Services sector</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Must hold valid driving licence recognised by the Traffic Police.</li><li>• Can drive during work as part of Job Flexibility Scheme.</li><li>• No need to hold driving-related occupations.</li><li>• Note: Employers are reminded to use job flexibility sensibly and reasonably.</li></ul>
<b>S Pass holders</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Must hold valid driving licence recognised by the Traffic Police.</li><li>• Must be required in their course of work.</li><li>• Must be in accordance with their occupation stated on their S-Pass.</li></ul>
<b>Employment Pass (EP) holders</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Must hold valid driving licence recognised by the Traffic Police.</li><li>• No occupational restrictions.</li></ul>
